



MAJOR ISSUES to Resolve Based on Results from the WASH Survey for Catholic Healthcare Facilities:




* Improved water sources include piped water, boreholes or tubewells, protected dug wells, protected springs & rainwater

MAJOR ISSUES to Resolve Based on Results from the WASH Survey for Catholic Healthcare Facilities:



* [Improved sanitation facilities](#) include flush/pour flush to piped sewer system, septic tanks or pit latrines; ventilated improved pit latrines; composting toilets; or pit latrines with slabs.

MAJOR ISSUES to Resolve Based on Results from the WASH Survey for Catholic Healthcare Facilities:



* Safe methods of infectious & sharps waste disposal include incineration and burial in a lined, protected pit.

** Safe method of placenta disposal is burial in a lined, protected pit. Patients may bring home placentas if they have been disinfected first.
