DEPENDENCE

"Habitual reliance on a substance or product . . . for which the individual experiences an irrepressible need, and the deprivation of which can cause mental and physical disturbances."

DRUGS, DEPENDENCE AND ADDICTIONS

- DRUGS
- Psychoactive Substances
- ALCOHOL
- TOBACCO

- INTERNET/PORNOGRAPHY
- GAMING/GAMBLING







DRUGS: Marijuana, Cocaine, Heroin, etc.

- Cocaine is associated with an increase in the consumption of heroin, which "still accounts for the majority, around 80%, of new opioid-related treatment demands in Europe" (European Drug Report, 2017).
- Intoxicating NEW PSYCHOACTIVE SUBSTANCES (NPS) and extremely
 potent synthetic drugs, favoured among young people, are
 easily accessible, cost little and can be ordered online.
- Cannabis still holds primacy in terms of consumption, and International debate continues on its use for therapy and/or recreation.

DRUGS: Marijuana, Cocaine, Heroin, etc.

- FENTANYL:
 - NORTH AMERICAN OPIOID CRISIS
 - 63,000 DRUG-RELATED DEATHS IN U.S. 2017

• TRAMADOL:

West and North Africa, Middle East



- 31 MILLION suffer from drug use disorders (point of addiction requiring treatment)
 - Only **1 in 6** persons actually receive this treatment

NEW PSYCHOACTIVE SUBSTANCES

"Substances of abuse, either in a pure form or in preparation, that are not controlled under the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs of 1961 or the 1971 Convention, but that may pose a public health threat."

- XANAX, PROZAC, ATIVAN, ETC.
- KETAMINE:
 veterinary, surgery drug > hallucinogen, sexual assault
- BATH SALTS

ALCOHOL, TOBACCO [INTERNET AND GAMING]

- Moral duty to safeguard and preserve health, and with it life
- Alcohol dependence and Highly deleterious effects for the person's physical, psychological, and spiritual health.
- Health care policies, health care workers: prevention and dissuasion, educational activities

3. REHABILITATION: FREEDOM FROM SLAVERY
